

## **Knock Motorcycle & Car Club NW Beach Race Portrush Friday 8th May**

**Paddock opens for riders at 8.30am to 11am sharp no exceptions.**

**No vehicles aloud to leave until 30 minutes after event is over as per the council.**

**Briefing for the Beach race from Clerk of the Course Wesley Sloan will be held @11.30pm  
Riders must attend**

At this event you will be using public areas, were space and time are restricted, the following will be strictly adhered to.

The local authorities governing these areas have strict rules and measures that need to be meet for the running of this and future events.

### **1. Parking in Paddock Area,**

1. 1 vehicle per rider, this will be checked in by club officials at the gate entrance
2. All vehicles **MUST** be in the Paddock area before 11am **NO ADMISSION** after this time.
3. Strictly **NO OVER NIGHT CAMPING** in the carpark.
4. The carpark must be clear of all event vehicles by 6.30pm.

### **2. Signing on**

1. Friday 8th May from 9am to 11am in the water sports centre beside the carpark.

### **3. Beach Holding Area**

1. When you put your bike or quad is put into the holding area in the morning on the beach it stays there for the day.
2. If you take your machine back to the paddock you cannot return to the holding area your is day finished.
3. The entrance to the beach holding area will be open half an hour before start of practice and half hour after the last race has finished
4. The council has stipulated the public walkway can only be closed at these times to facilitate access to the beach.
5. **All machines MUST be on the beach before 11.30am.**

### **4. Refuelling Area**

1. There will be a refuel area as you come off the track with mats to refuel on. Please fill the machine before you come down to the beach.
2. Spill kits available if needed.
3. No fuel canister to be stored on beach. When you have refuelled, the canister must be taken back to the main paddock.

### **5. No tear offs allowed on googles.**

6. Visual technical inspection and noise control  
This will be at the paddock exit to the track.

8. **Start of Race will be by LIGHT SYSTEM**

1. you will be called forward to the line red lights will be on, when the red lights go out race starts.

9. **No machine washing available or permitted on the site**

10. **Lap scoring** will be manual ( if your numbers are hard to read you will not be lap scored it's that simple)

1. Riders must ensure the number on the machine is the same as on the entry

11. Presentation for each class will be at the commentary point immediately after the last race where every rider will receive a medal.

12. Failure to comply with the club's agents' instructions and measures may lead to exclusion from the event.

13. **TAKE ALL RUBBISH HOME!** do not leave any rubbish on the beach. We need to look after this event and we will have plenty of eyes on us from the council. A lot of time and effort goes on behind the scenes to make this event happen.
