SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the Motorcycle Racing Association (Ireland) Ltd Competition Rules and Standing Regulations including any Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event.

2. Eligibility

The event is open to riders competing on quad or solo motorcycles who are holding a current competition license issued by the MRA and MCUI (SC)., A.C.U. or S.A.C.U. & Continental FMN's

5. Events

Classes

6. Entries

These must be made on an Official Entry Form completed in every detail and accompanied by the Full Entry Fee. Entry fees will only be returned in the event of the meeting being cancelled. The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry or to return any entry already received. Entry fee £20 all classes. Entries are limited to 10 per class **Races will not be timed so transponders not needed.**

7. Riders Briefing

All riders should attend the riders briefing for final instructions prior to commencing practice.

8. Practice

Drivers must complete at least one lap of the course in practice which will be run in a controlled manner for Youth 13:00 Adults 16:00 (Approx.)

9. Paddock and Coastal Path

Strictly no overnight parking in the carpark on Thursday and Friday evening. Carpark must be vacated by 20.00 on Friday evening or you will be fined.

Riding of machines in the paddock or coastal path is strictly prohibited. Bikes/quads are not permitted to go back and forth to paddock during the event. In exceptional circumstances riders and Quads may ride to and from the holding area only if permitted by the Clerk of the Course but riders must not exceed first gear idle when travelling to and from the holding area and must always wear a helmet. If any accident or

incident occurs to either themselves (the rider) or ANY other person(s) or property, liability lays with the rider or if under 18 years of age their Parent / Guardian.

Pit bikes, electric bikes, scooters or quads are strictly prohibited in the paddock, in spectator areas or trackside. Only people with a disability can make use of a pit bike, electric bike, scooter or quad. Such people must seek and gain permission from the Clerk of the Course before using a pit bike, electric bike, scooter or quad. Such people must not exceed a walking pace. If any accident or incident occurs to either themselves (the person using the pit bike, electric bike, scooter or quad) or ANY other person(s) or property, liability lays with the person using the pit bike, electric bike, scooter or quad, or if under 18 years of age their Parent / Guardian.

10. Beach Holding Area

- a. The entrance to the beach holding area will be open half an hour before start of practice and after the last race has finished
- b. The council has stipulated the public walkway can only be closed at these times to facilitate access to the beach.
- c. Racing Machines cannot be removed from the holding area until the event is over

11. Refuelling Area

- d. There will be a refuel area as you come off the track with mats to refuel on. Refuelling in the carpark is prohibited.
- e. Spill kits available if needed.

12. Tear Offs

No tear offs allowed on goggles.

13. Start of a Race

A clutch start with a back folding starting gate or Traffic lights will be employed. The Co-Operation of the drivers in entering the Assembly Area promptly is required. Late arrival at the Assembly Area will mean exclusion from that race. Machines may only be started in the Assembly Area on instructions from the Paddock Marshals.

14. Course

One full lap measures 400 metres approx. consist of rough going marked with rope, stakes and flags. Flag or marker cutting may entail exclusion, any driver leaving the course must return to it at the point at which he left it. An exclusion penalty will apply, except where it is inadvertent and no advantage is gained.

15. Technical Visual Inspection of Machines and Signing on Drivers/Passengers

Before commencing practice, Drivers may have to present their machines, clothing and helmet in racing condition for checking. Crash helmets must bear the 2025 M.R.A. stamp. Each driver and passenger must have a current competition license available for inspection when signing on. It is the riders/parents/guardian's responsibility to ensure their machine is mechanically safe & in a race worthy condition, adhering to the technical specification for that machine including riders PPE.

16. Finish of a race

To be classified a finisher a competitor must have completed 75% of the distance covered by the race winner and have crossed the finishing line within five minutes after the race winner has finished.

17. Stopping a race

A race if stopped prematurely for reasons of force majeure, may be run at the discretion of the promoters with the permission of the stewards. A race will be re-run should there be a false start.

18. Flag Signals

The International Code of Signals will be used and such signals must be obeyed instantly as failure to do so may result in exclusion. A yellow flag with a black cross will indicate the last lap of a race.

19. Red Flags

If a race is stopped because of a rider/s lying on the course, that rider or riders will not be allowed to restart the race

20. Signalling

All signalling for a driver must be carried out from the designated area and the onus is on the competitor to make sure that his signaller complies to this request.

21. Medical Assistance

Any rider refusing medical attention deemed necessary after a fall will not be allowed to race further on the day

23. No personal information given to the Club will be passed to outside parties without prior written consent.
